Austin ISD partners with Panorama Education to measure school climate and culture. Panorama's comprehensive survey tools empower educators to identify strengths and opportunities, inform decision-making, and monitor progress over time.



Who will participate in this initiative?

Students (grades 3-12), staff and families participate. Once results are available, school teams receive support and resources to analyze and act on the data and progress is shared with the community.

What do these surveys measure?

These surveys measure school climate, culture, engagement and more. Topics were chosen based on stakeholder input through focus groups and align to the district's scorecard and strategic priorities.

How do I know I can trust the data?

Panorama's surveys were developed in partnership with Harvard's Graduate School of Education. Each instrument follows survey design best practices. Participation is monitored to ensure a representative voice.

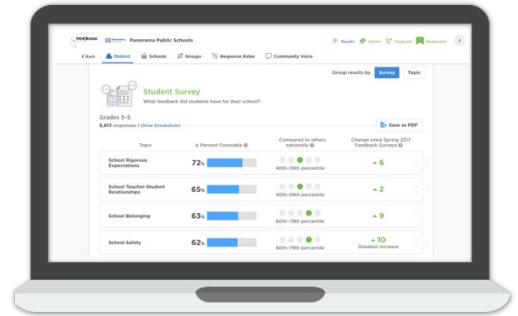

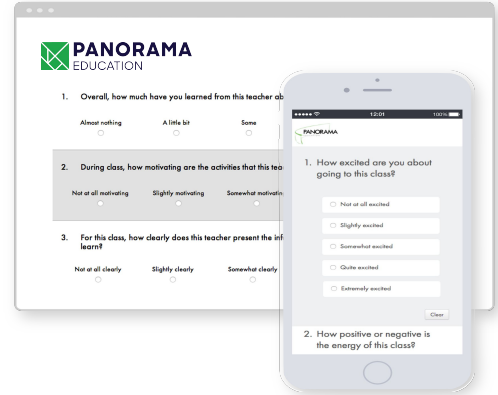

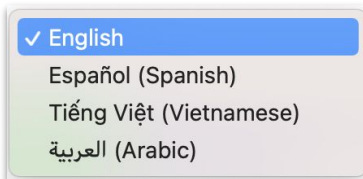
How do I complete the Austin ISD Family Survey?

- ✓ Responses are recorded when the blue “**Submit**” button is clicked.




